## Takeaways & Suggestions from 1<sup>st</sup> Global Ex-NCLites Meet:

- Who are NCL Alumni? NCL Alumni is anyone who was/is associated with NCL in research capacity. Thus:
  - Ex-NClites PhDs, Ex-Employees who are presently associated with other organizations, Retirees, Entrepreneurs, Person worked/served in NCL as Pool officers, Project Assistants, M.Sc./M.Tech. Students, etc.
  - 2. Current Ph.D. students, Research Associates and Project Assistants
  - 3. NCL Staff- Scientists Guiding the Research students/Teaching M.Tech. Students.
- Strengthening of NCL Alumni Association: Dr. Sourav Pal, Director, NCL discussed the need to strengthen the NCL Alumni Association. For this, he agreed to provide an office and office staff for the NCL Alumni Association. Further, he welcomed the suggestion of Dr. S. Sivaram during the inaugural session. Dr. Sivaram had suggested that NCL can collect Rs. 500/year from the contingency grant of JRF/SRF working in NCL for Alumni activities. Director promised to initiate steps towards this end. There was also a suggestion from Dr. S. Sivaram (during the inaugural session), to plan NCL Alumni meet in the US and other parts of the world. In US it may be linked to ACS meeting and NCL Director may be invited to address the Alumni.
- **Lifetime Membership:** There was also a suggestion to increase the life membership fee of the NCL Alumni Association from the existing Rs. 500/- to Rs. 2000/-
- Awards & Other Activities: The scope of activities of the Alumni in addition to the annual meeting was also discussed during the meeting. Depending on the availability of funds, these are:

- 1) <u>Instituting Awards</u> under various categories (An award committee to be formed with Director, NCL as the chair person and categories and criteria for the selection of the awardees to be decided. A corpus fund for this purpose has to be created through corporate /institute/individual donations).
- 2) <u>Financial support to wards of NCL staff</u> with excellent academic records, for higher education.
- 3) <u>Outreach Program covering villages in India</u> for overall development in educational, social, societal, infrastructural.... areas.
